

4 Waste Minimisation Award rewards organisations that have reduced the waste they produce – and increased recycling.

>>> **Business Design Centre**

- > Useable waste is collected for Children's Scrap Project
- > Paper, cardboard, plastics and glass is recycled
- > Plan to increase recycling by 27% this year

>>> **National Deaf Children's Society**

- > Sends computer equipment to Computer Aid
- > Educates staff about reducing waste
- > Recycles all paper, glass, plastics, mobile phones, ink cartridges and clothes

>>> **Duke of Cambridge**

- > Has a reduced packaging policy and does not use bottled water
- > Furniture from recycled sources
- > All food waste is composted and tins, paper, cardboard and glass is recycled

>>> **Slaughter and May**

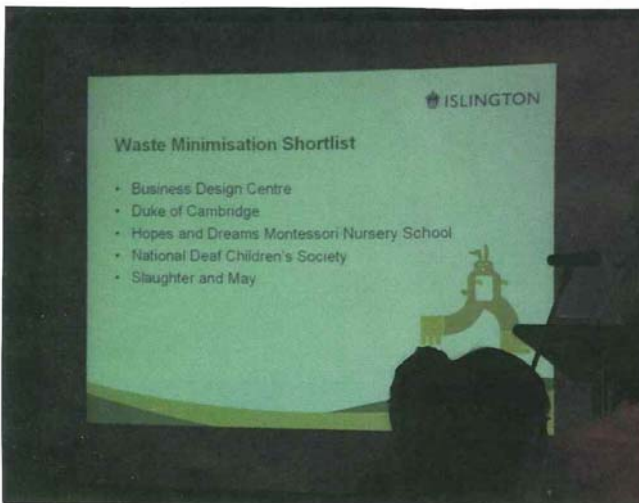
- > Uses biodegradable cups and has removed all plastic cutlery from lunch rooms
- > Increased staff awareness and developed a pledge system
- > No waste send to landfill
- > Food waste send for processing and converted into energy

>>> **Hopes and Dreams**

- > Monitor printing and enforce double sided printing rule
- > Reusable cups for water
- > RecycleArt project to help children make art from waste
