

## Corona Virus Update – 16/03/20 – 12pm

We are continuing to follow the guidelines from the Public Health Website and we are currently remaining open until the advice changes.

Some additional internal measures that we are taking are:

- Suspending all extra-curriculum classes until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April
- Suspending all Parent Tours until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April
- Postponing all excursion until further notice inclusive of the visits to the Postal Museum 27<sup>th</sup> March and 3<sup>rd</sup> April
- Suspending all offsite outdoor play and extending outdoor periods in the garden for all groups to ensure daily outdoor activity continues
- All events are being cancelled **including Mother Day's Tea this Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March**
- Supervising the children's handwashing to ensure they use soap and wash for the required 20 seconds

### Anyone Showing Sign or Symptoms

If any children develop a raised temperature and/or a new continuous cough whilst at Nursery School, you will be required to collect them immediately or as soon as feasibly possible and will need to keep them home for a minimum of seven days or until the symptoms have stopped.

If either you or your child show any of these symptoms at home, then please do not bring your child to Nursery School, again for a minimum of seven days or until the symptoms have stopped. Please inform the Nursery School at your earliest convenience.

Similarly, staff showing any symptoms will also be sent home and required to stay away for the same period as per government guidelines.
